I. Introduction to Meteorology

- **Definition of Meteorology:** The study of the atmosphere and its phenomena, including weather and climate.

 - Exosphere: Outermost layer, gradually fades into space.

III. Heat Transfer

- **Conduction:** Heat transfer through direct contact (e.g., the ground warming the air above it).
- **Convection:** Heat transfer through the movement of fluids (liquids or gases) (e.g., warm air rising and cool air sinking).
- **Radiation:** Heat transfer through electromagnetic waves (e.g., the sun's energy warming the Earth).

IV. Atmospheric Pressure and Wind

- **Atmospheric Pressure:** The force exerted by the weight of the atmosphere.
