Most people learn about incentives before they can even remember—basic incentives being causal relationships like “don’t touch a hot stove if you don’t want to get burned.” The interplay of moral, social, and economic incentives is complex, and incentives nearly always are linked, though one often takes the lead. The authors go to great lengths to show how incentives can be positive, such as making more money on the sale of a home, or negative, such as altering students’ test scores. Yet they are careful to remain objective in their depictions of the positive and negative consequences of incentives since economics is not the study of declaring whether or not something is morally right or wrong.
